Under counter boards usually have a finger grip on opposite ends and opposite sides of the board, so both sides can be pulled out and used.

Face grain boards are simpler to make and can be 3/4" to 1 7/16" thick. No wider than 20" and any length.

End grain boards are more time consuming but better for butcher blocks and can be 1" to 4" thick. No wider than 20" and any length.

Wood color comes in so many different earth tones that there is no way to list them all. Light colors are generally from oak, poplar and maple and dark colors are generally from walnut, sapele and mahogany (to name a few). There are lots of exotic woods that come in purple to red and everything in between... perfect for the center line or accents.
